## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation a portion of the assessed value
- 3 of the residence homesteads of volunteer firefighters, emergency
- 4 medical services volunteers, and individuals serving as foster
- 5 parents.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 8 is amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 9 <u>(j)</u> The legislature by general law may exempt from ad
- 10 valorem taxation \$5,000 of the assessed value of the residence
- 11 homestead of a person who serves as a volunteer firefighter,
- 12 <u>emergency medical services volunteer, or foster parent.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 17 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation a portion of the
- 18 assessed value of the residence homesteads of volunteer
- 19 firefighters, emergency medical services volunteers, and
- 20 individuals serving as foster parents."
