A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment permitting an encumbrance to
- 2 be fixed on homestead property for an obligation to pay certain
- 3 property owners' association fees and fines without permitting the
- 4 forced sale of the homestead.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 50, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (w) to read as follows:
- 8 (w) An obligation to pay property owners' association fees
- 9 <u>for maintenance and ownership of common facilities</u> and services or
- 10 to pay other fees or fines imposed by a property owners' association
- 11 is a debt for which an encumbrance may be fixed on homestead
- 12 property. The homestead, however, is protected from forced sale
- 13 for the payment of a debt described by this subsection.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment permitting an
- 18 encumbrance to be fixed on homestead property for an obligation to
- 19 pay certain property owners' association fees and fines without
- 20 permitting the forced sale of the homestead."
