## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment increasing the state general
- 2 sales and use tax rate and dedicating the increased state revenue to
- 3 public education and property tax relief.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article VII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 5b to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5b. The school equalization fund consists of:
- 8 (1) certain proceeds of the state sales and use tax, as
- 9 provided by Section 25, Article VIII, of this constitution; and
- 10 (2) other funds transferred or dedicated to the fund
- 11 by general law.
- 12 SECTION 2. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 13 adding Section 25 to read as follows:
- Sec. 25. (a) The state shall impose the sales and use tax
- 15 authorized by Chapter 151, Tax Code, or its successor, at the rate
- 16 of seven percent.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) of this section, the
- 18 legislature by general law may raise or lower the rate of the tax or
- 19 modify or repeal the tax.
- 20 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 21 constitution, the net revenue derived from an increase in the rate
- 22 of the tax described by Subsection (a) of this section over the rate
- 23 of the tax on August 31, 2009, shall be deposited, as determined by
- 24 the legislature, to the credit of:

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- 1 (1) the school equalization fund; or
- 2 (2) the property tax relief fund or that fund's
- 3 <u>successor.</u>
- 4 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 5 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 6 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 7 proposition: "The constitutional amendment increasing the sales
- 8 and use tax rate and dedicating the increased state revenue to
- 9 public education and property tax relief."
