A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt a portion of the assessed value of the residence
- 3 homesteads of certain military servicemembers who have served in a
- 4 hostile fire or imminent danger pay zone or a combat zone.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(j) The legislature by general law may exempt from ad</u>
- 9 valorem taxation by a political subdivision a portion of the
- 10 <u>assessed value of the residence homestead of a person who is a</u>
- 11 member or former member of the armed forces of the United States, of
- 12 the Texas National Guard or of the National Guard of another state,
- 13 or of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States
- 14 and has served in a hostile fire or imminent danger pay zone
- 15 designated by the secretary of state of the United States or a
- 16 combat zone designated by the president of the United States. The
- 17 legislature may provide for the computation of the amount of the
- 18 exemption based on the period of that service and may provide that a
- 19 person may not claim an exemption in more than one tax year for the
- 20 same period of service. Where ad valorem taxes have previously been
- 21 pledged for the payment of debt, the taxing officers of a political
- 22 <u>subdivision may continue to levy and collect the taxes against the</u>
- 23 value of homesteads exempted under this subsection until the debt
- 24 is discharged if the cessation of the levy would impair the

- 1 obligation of the contract by which the debt was created. The
- 2 legislature shall provide for formulas to protect school districts
- 3 against all or part of the revenue loss incurred by the
- 4 implementation of this subsection.
- 5 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 6 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 7 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 8 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 9 legislature to exempt a portion of the assessed value of the
- 10 residence homesteads of certain military servicemembers who have
- 11 served in a hostile fire or imminent danger pay zone or a combat
- 12 zone."
