A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment abolishing school district
- 2 maintenance and operations ad valorem taxes.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 1-e-1 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1-e-1. Notwithstanding any other law, beginning on
- 7 January 1, 2014, a political subdivision of this state may not levy
- 8 an ad valorem tax for the purpose of maintaining an efficient system
- 9 of public free schools.
- 10 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 11 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 12 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 13 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to abolish school
- 14 district maintenance and operations ad valorem taxes beginning on
- 15 January 1, 2014, in order that the legislature may enact a fairer
- 16 system of fully funding public education."
