A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the governor to

- 2 grant a pardon to certain persons under specific circumstances.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 11(b), Article IV, Texas Constitution,
- 5 is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) In all criminal cases, except treason and impeachment,
- 7 the Governor shall have power, after conviction or successful
- 8 completion of a term of deferred adjudication community
- 9 supervision, on the written signed recommendation and advice of the
- 10 Board of Pardons and Paroles, or a majority thereof, to grant
- 11 reprieves and commutations of punishment and pardons, including a
- 12 posthumous pardon for actual innocence. Under [; and under] such
- 13 rules as the Legislature may prescribe, and upon the written
- 14 recommendation and advice of a majority of the Board of Pardons and
- 15 Paroles, the Governor [he] shall have the power to remit fines and
- 16 forfeitures. The Governor shall have the power to grant one
- 17 reprieve in any capital case for a period not to exceed thirty (30)
- 18 days. The Governor [; and he] shall have power to revoke
- 19 conditional pardons. With the advice and consent of the
- 20 Legislature, the Governor [he] may grant reprieves, commutations of
- 21 punishment and pardons in cases of treason.
- 22 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 23 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
