## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing a federally
- 2 recognized Indian tribe in a county along the Texas-Mexico
- 3 international border to conduct certain gaming activity on certain
- 4 tribal lands.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) The Legislature shall pass laws prohibiting lotteries
- 10 and gift enterprises in this State other than those authorized by
- 11 Subsections (b), (d), [and] (e), and (f) of this section.
- 12 (f) The Ysleta del Sur Pueblo Indian tribe may conduct
- 13 gaming activity described under or by Indian Gaming Regulatory Act
- 14 (Pub. L. No. 100-497) that would otherwise be subject to the
- 15 prohibition prescribed by (a) of this section on land that was
- 16 recognized as tribal land of that tribe by the United States on
- 17 January 1, 1998.
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the Ysleta
- 22 del Sur Pueblo Indian tribe to conduct gaming activity on certain
- 23 tribal lands."
