A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to municipal and 2 county financing of the acquisition of buffer areas or open spaces 3 adjacent to a military installation for certain purposes

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by 6 adding Section 52k to read as follows:

Sec. 52-k. The legislature by general law may authorize a municipality or county to issue bonds or notes to finance the acquisition of buffer areas or open spaces adjacent to a military installation for the prevention of encroachment or for the construction of roadways or infrastructure to protect or promote the mission of the military installation.

13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009. The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 15 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing municipalities and counties to issue bonds and notes to finance the 17 acquisition of buffer areas or open spaces adjacent to a military 18 installation for the prevention of encroachment or for the 19 construction of roadways or infrastructure to protect or promote 20 21 the mission of the military installation."
