A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment disqualifying certain persons
- 2 from service in the Legislature.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 7-a to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 7-a. DISQUALIFICATION OF CERTAIN PERSONS FROM SERVICE
- 7 IN THE LEGISLATURE. No person shall be a member of either House if
- 8 the person has been finally convicted of a felony, regardless of
- 9 whether the person has fully discharged the person's sentence,
- 10 including any term of incarceration, parole, or supervision, or
- 11 completed a period of probation ordered by any court or has been
- 12 pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disability to
- 13 <u>vote.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment disqualifying persons
- 18 who have been finally convicted of a felony from service in the
- 19 Legislature."
