WHEREAS, After graduating from The University of Texas at Austin, Dr. Troxell went on to earn his master's degree in education from Texas State University-San Marcos and his Ph.D. from UT-Austin; a former middle-school teacher, he has 18 years of experience in administration and served as an assistant superintendent in the Cypress-Fairbanks Independent School District before joining Kerrville ISD as superintendent in 2003; in addition, he has taught as an adjunct professor at Schreiner University and the University of Houston and as a part-time

professor at Sam Houston State University; and

students, faculty, and campuses in the district have received numerous honors; Fred H. Tally Elementary School was the only elementary school in Texas to be named a 2007 National Title I Distinguished School, and Tivy High School has been named a Region 20 Outstanding High School in math and science; moreover, the Texas Education Agency has accorded the Kerrville school system its highest financial rating for six consecutive years; the district's sound economic footing has allowed it to offer teachers some of the highest salaries in the Hill Country and to challenge students with such diverse courses and activities as the orchestra program, the elementary Spanish program, and Challenge Labs for high achievers; in addition, Dr. Troxell himself was recognized with the 2006 Advocate of the Gifted award from the Texas Association for the Gifted and Talented; and
