1           WHEREAS, Residents of Hunt lost a respected fellow citizen  
2 with the passing of Jack Dell Stone, Sr., on September 1, 2007, at  
3 the age of 86; and

4           WHEREAS, A native of California, Mr. Stone was born on June  
5 22, 1921, in Los Angeles; during his years at Beverly Hills High  
6 School, he served as a drum major in the marching band and earned  
7 his pilot's license; after graduation, he was accepted into the  
8 prestigious California Institute of Technology, where he earned a  
9 degree in chemical engineering; and

10           WHEREAS, Mr. Stone went on to serve his country in the Pacific  
11 Theater as a member of the U.S. Navy; at the end of World War II, he  
12 moved to Houston and gained employment with the Fluor Corporation;

14           WHEREAS, He shared more than half a century of marriage with  
15 his wife, Patricia, with whom he raised four children and was  
16 further blessed with 13 grandchildren; and

17           WHEREAS, In retirement, Mr. Stone relocated to Hunt and  
18 became active in the Kerrville Bible Church, where he performed  
19 several service ministries; and

20           WHEREAS, Those fortunate enough to have known Jack Stone will  
21 remember his strong faith and his love of family, community, and  
22 country; though he will be deeply missed, his memory will live on in  
23 the hearts of the many people whose lives he touched; now,  
24 therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas  
2 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Jack Dell Stone, Sr.,  
3 and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to his  
4 wife, Patricia Conway Stone; to his sons, Jack Stone, Jr., and his  
5 wife, Kathy, Patrick Stone and his wife, Sonya, and Bill Stone and  
6 his wife, Janelle; to his daughter, Jennifer Rose and her husband,
