21 WHEREAS, Held in high regard by other community leaders, Mr. 22 Currie was asked to act as Santa Claus numerous times by the chamber 23 of commerce, the members of his church, and the Brady ISD; in 1986 24 he was named Citizen of the Year, and in 2000 the chamber of
