2 Police Department in January 2009, drawing to a close a notable
3 career in law enforcement that has spanned 45 years; and

4 WHEREAS, A third-generation police officer, Buddy Frazier
5 majored in criminal justice and police administration in college;
6 he is also a graduate of the Harris County Sheriff's Academy and the
7 FBI National Academy; and

8 WHEREAS, Chief Frazier began his law enforcement career in
9 1963 with the Memorial Village Police Department, where he was
10 promoted through the ranks until his retirement in 1983; and

11 WHEREAS, That same year he began again as a patrolman in the
12 Katy Police Department, where he subsequently was promoted to
13 patrol sergeant, patrol captain, and captain of the Criminal
14 Investigation Division; in 1996, he was appointed chief of police;

16 WHEREAS, Chief Frazier has guided the Katy Police Department
17 with a steady hand through a period of expansion; eventually
18 commanding a force of 60 people, he has earned the respect and
19 admiration of his officers and staff, as well as the high esteem of
20 law enforcement professionals across the state; and

21 WHEREAS, Chief Frazier's dedication, professionalism, and
22 integrity have greatly benefited his community, and he may indeed
23 reflect with pride on his many years of service as he prepares to
24 embark on the next exciting chapter of his life; now, therefore, be
