1 WHEREAS, Dr. T. David Greer is lending his time and talents to
2 aid the Texas House of Representatives as Physician of the Day for
3 January 15, 2009; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Henrietta, David Greer completed his
5 studies at The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston and
6 joined the United States Army following his graduation in 1964; he
7 completed an internship at Letterman General Hospital in San
8 Francisco and became a flight surgeon in 1965; he was later
9 stationed in Germany and Vietnam, and for his dedicated military
10 service he earned numerous commendations, including a Bronze Star
11 with Oak Leaf Clusters, an Air Medal with eight Oak Leaf Clusters,
12 an Army Commendation Medal, and a Purple Heart; and

13 WHEREAS, This accomplished Texan has operated a private
14 practice in Henrietta for nearly four decades and has become a
15 respected and well-known figure in his hometown and in the
16 surrounding area; holding specialty certification from the
17 American Board of Family Medicine, he is also a member of the
18 American Academy of Family Physicians as well as the national and
19 state medical associations; moreover, he is involved in the Texas
20 Academy of Family Physicians, and that organization named him its
21 2004 Physician of the Year; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Greer has built an admirable career by devoting
23 himself to the health and well-being of others, and it is a pleasure
24 to recognize him at this time and to gratefully welcome him to the
