1           WHEREAS, Sherry Cannedy of Wichita Falls has received the  
2 2008 Linden Heck Howell Outstanding Teaching of Texas History Award  
3 from Humanities Texas; and

4           WHEREAS, The state affiliate of the National Endowment for  
5 the Humanities, the nonprofit Humanities Texas honors one teacher  
6 of Texas history every year as part of its annual Outstanding  
7 Teaching Awards; the Texas history award is named in memory of  
8 Linden Heck Howell, a former chair of the organization's board; the  
9 winning teacher receives \$5,000 and his or her school receives \$500  
10 for the purchase of teaching materials; and

11           WHEREAS, Ms. Cannedy teaches fourth grade social studies,  
12 reading, and writing at Southern Hills Elementary in Wichita Falls;  
13 she attended Texas Tech University and earned her teaching degree  
14 at Midwestern State University; and

15           WHEREAS, Known affectionately by her students as "Mrs.  
16 Texas," this dynamic educator sparks interest in Texas history by  
17 taking her students on field trips to the State Capitol and the  
18 Alamo and other Spanish missions; she encourages her students to  
19 share their knowledge of Texas history with their parents; and

20           WHEREAS, Ms. Cannedy has written and directed a pageant of  
21 Texas history titled "The Spirit of Texas," performed every San  
22 Jacinto Day by the students at her school; she also shares her love  
23 of Texas history as a facilitator for the Lone Star Leadership  
24 Academy; and

1           WHEREAS, By instilling in her students a deep appreciation of  
2 the history and traditions of the Lone Star State, Ms. Cannedy plays  
3 a vital role in the growth of Texas culture, and she indeed merits  
4 commendation for the great contribution she is making to her school  
5 and her community; now, therefore, be it

6           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas  
7 Legislature hereby congratulate Sherry Cannedy on winning the 2008  
8 Linden Heck Howell Outstanding Teaching of Texas History Award and  
9 extend to her sincere best wishes for continued success and
