18 Texan is a senior at Cypress-Ridge High School, where he plays
19 trumpet with the band; he is also a trained lifeguard and an
20 experienced summer camp counselor; and

21 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Davis's dedication to excellence and
22 perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy to
23 stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with pride
24 on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

2 Legislature hereby congratulate Eric Davis on achieving the rank of
3 Eagle Scout and extend to him sincere best wishes for continued
4 success and happiness; and, be it further
