1 WHEREAS, Melvin A. Arnold has reached a significant milestone 2 in his extraordinary 60-year career in law enforcement with his 3 retirement in 2008 as chief deputy sheriff of the Jim Wells County 4 Sheriff Department in Alice; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in 1927 in Lott, Mr. Arnold began his career as 6 a peace officer in 1948 with the Robstown Police Department; he took 7 time away from the department to serve his nation as a United States 8 Marine, receiving his honorable discharge at the rank of sergeant 9 in 1952; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Arnold returned to the Robstown PD following his military service, and, until he left the department in 1980, he distinguished himself in a number of positions, including traffic officer, patrol sergeant, assistant chief, and captain of detectives; he served twice as chief of the department; and

WHEREAS, In 1981, Mr. Arnold went to work for the Jim Wells County Sheriff Department, where he served as chief deputy sheriff for nearly 30 years; although he has retired from that position, he continues to stand ready as a member of the department's reserve force, making him one of the oldest active peace officers in Texas; and
