4 WHEREAS, Dan Savage began his career in 1972 with the City of
5 Wichita Falls; three years later, he became assistant city manager
6 of Baytown, and later served as city manager of The Colony and
7 Duncanville; and

8 WHEREAS, In 1996, Mr. Savage joined the staff of the Dallas
9 County Commissioners Court, and during his tenure as assistant
10 administrator, he has overseen a number of notable projects,
11 including the restoration of the Old Red Courthouse, remodeling of
12 the Allen Courthouse, and construction of the Dallas County
13 Institute for Forensic Science and the south tower jail; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Savage has shared his expertise with the
15 International City Management Association and the Texas City
16 Management Association, and he has held several leadership
17 positions with the North Central Texas Council of Governments; he
18 has also served on the board of the Duncanville Chamber of Commerce,
19 Leadership Southwest, and the Duncanville Rotary Club; and

21 Shields, Dan Savage may reflect with pride on a career well spent,
