5 10 branches operate within the Katy Independent School District;

8 term, the BVSCU generously donated more than \$32,000 to Katy
9 schools for a variety of programs and activities; its contributions
10 include support of the "Doo-Wop to Disco" fundraising event,

12 teacher gift cards, and hiring a mariachi band for the dedication of
