R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Rosemary Karr of Plano has made an enduring
2 contribution to Collin College and to the State of Texas through her
3 significant achievements in mathematics education; and

4 WHEREAS, During her tenure at Collin College, which has
5 spanned nearly two decades, Dr. Karr has earned acclaim for the
6 innovative way in which she teaches developmental math and helps
7 students to overcome their fear of the subject; in addition to her
8 record of success in her own classes, she designed the Passport
9 self-paced instructional program, which has proven a highly
10 successful method of teaching college-level math; and

11 WHEREAS, Her work has been recognized with a number of
12 awards; most notably, she was named a U.S. Professor of the Year for
13 2007; this prestigious honor is sponsored by the Council for the
14 Advancement and Support of Education and the Carnegie Foundation
15 for the Advancement of Teaching and is presented to just four
16 professors in the United States each calendar year; moreover, she
17 garnered the 2007 National Association for Developmental Education
18 Award for Outstanding Service to Developmental Education Students;

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Karr earned undergraduate and master's degrees
21 from Eastern Kentucky University and holds a doctorate in higher
22 education from the University of North Texas; she was a tenured
23 professor at her alma mater of Eastern Kentucky before joining the
24 Collin College faculty in 1990; and

1 WHEREAS, Approaching her teaching duties with imagination
2 and commitment, Rosemary Karr has had a profound impact on her
3 students, and she is most deserving of the illustrious recognition
4 she has attained; now, therefore, be it

6 Legislature hereby congratulate Dr. Rosemary Karr on her
7 exceptional professional accomplishments and extend to her sincere
