

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives takes great pride  
2 in recognizing the members of Leadership Lewisville from  
3 Lewisville, Texas, on the occasion of their visit to Austin  
4 February 9 and 10, 2009; and

5           WHEREAS, Sponsored by the Lewisville Chamber of Commerce,  
6 Leadership Lewisville is part of the chamber's Community  
7 Development Division; and

8           WHEREAS, The goals of Leadership Lewisville include  
9 providing a unique educational experience for those who participate  
10 in the program and helping them to develop their leadership skills;  
11 the program also aims to motivate emerging leaders and help them to  
12 acquire a working knowledge of the community; and

13           WHEREAS, Anyone who works or resides in the greater  
14 Lewisville area is eligible to apply for admission to the program;  
15 and

16           WHEREAS, Managed by the Leadership Lewisville Steering  
17 Committee, the program requires students to attend one school board  
18 meeting and one city council meeting during the nine-month session;

20           WHEREAS, Having its participants learn the inner workings of  
21 private and public institutions and how and where one might make  
22 contributions to the community are the desired ends of Leadership  
23 Lewisville; and

24           WHEREAS, The class of 20 to 30 members is chosen without

1 regard to race, gender, age, education, or personal or employment  
2 affiliations; and

3 WHEREAS, Through its efforts to build a more informed and  
4 involved citizenry and to develop new leaders, Leadership  
5 Lewisville is helping to create a brighter and more promising  
6 future for the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas  
8 Legislature hereby commend Leadership Lewisville for its  
9 innovative and thorough approach to preparing citizens for  
10 prominent roles in their community; and, be it further

11 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be prepared for  
12 Leadership Lewisville as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
13 House of Representatives.
