WHEREAS, The face of Texas is rapidly changing, and demographic trends indicate that Hispanics will likely make up a majority of the population within the next decade; as a result, the state is in great need of more certified bilingual teachers, and a program at the University of North Texas is wisely addressing that need; and

WHEREAS, In collaboration with the Texas Higher Education

WHEREAS, In collaboration with the Texas Higher Education 7 Coordinating Board, UNT is offering the Roberto R. Alonzo 8 9 Bilingual/ESL Education Scholars Program to provide tuition assistance and loan forgiveness as incentives for students to 10 pursue certification programs in bilingual or ESL education; 11 12 covering tuition, fees, and a small book allowance, the scholarships are available for up to 25 students and provide a total 13 14 of \$300,000 in funding to junior and senior education students at

UNT; and 15 WHEREAS, Students enrolled in this program must maintain at 16 least a 2.75 grade point average, meet financial aid requirements, 17 dedicate the majority of their classes to early childhood to 18 fourth-grade level bilingual or ESL courses, as well as agree to 19 teach full-time as a certified teacher in early childhood through 20 21 fourth-grade bilingual or ESL classes at a public school in Texas for five years; and 22

23 WHEREAS, Equipping future teachers with fluency in the 24 Spanish language that will facilitate the delivery of content in
