20 bars, biblical puzzles, gardenias and roses, and music; a charter  
21 member of St. Phillips Baptist Church, she stays abreast of her

23 which she watches faithfully every night; in addition, she is an  
24 enthusiastic fan of the San Antonio Spurs; and
