9 shared many joyous times before his passing in 2003; the loving
10 couple were blessed with three daughters, Paula, Debra, and Denise;

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Crenshaw actively supported her children in
13 their many endeavors, notably as leader of their Girl Scout troops
14 and as manager of their high school drill teams; she also managed
15 her daughter Debra's teen singing group, the Tydettes, and she
16 organized a teen club and a math tutoring program to benefit young
17 people in the area; and

18 WHEREAS, A longtime member of the Coliseum Park Baptist
19 Church, Mrs. Crenshaw was active with the Ministers' and Deacons'
20 Wives Club; she was an avid sports fan as well and took great
21 pleasure in the success of the San Antonio Spurs, cheering on the
22 team as it claimed the 2007 NBA championship; and

23 WHEREAS, For 80 years, Anne Crenshaw made the world a better
24 place for her family members, friends, and fellow citizens, and the

2 continues to inspire all who had the good fortune to know her; now,
