7 WHEREAS, Irving began its period of rapid growth in the 8 mid-20th century; the Plymouth Park Shopping Center opened in 1955, 9 the University of Dallas in 1956, and Irving Community Hospital in 10 1964; the creation of the Las Colinas and Valley Ranch 11 master-planned business and residential communities contributed 12 further to the city's growth, and from 1971 to 2008, the city was 13 the home of "America's Team," the Dallas Cowboys; and

14 WHEREAS, Today, with a population of nearly 210,000, Irving 15 boasts more than 10,000 companies, including the headquarters of 16 ExxonMobil, Kimberly-Clark, the Commercial Metals Company, and the 17 Fluor Corporation; over 45 companies in the Fortune 500 have a 18 presence in the city, including Amazon.com, Northrop Grumman, 19 Verizon, Microsoft, and many others; and

20 WHEREAS, Irving's educational and cultural resources make it 21 a fine place to live and work; the University of Dallas and North 22 Lake College offer ample opportunities for higher education, and 23 the city is home to the Irving Arts Center, as well as to three 24 symphony orchestras and two award-winning theater companies; and
