16 part of the Luster Products Company design team; and

17 WHEREAS, Devoted to his faith, Mr. Roberts was a member of
18 Concord Missionary Baptist Church in Dallas and a faithful visitor
19 of New Creation Christian Fellowship in San Antonio; he loved to
20 sing and was at one time a member of the Donald Belford Chorale; and

21 WHEREAS, Phillip Roberts built a life that was rich in
22 friends and family, and while he will be deeply missed, he will
23 always be remembered with great admiration and affection; now,
