R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, August 2008 was a special month for Pastor Carl
2 Dailey and Sister Ruth Dailey of San Antonio, as August 18th marked
3 their 46th wedding anniversary and August 14th was Pastor Dailey's
4 67th birthday; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of Cincinnati, Ohio, Pastor Dailey was born
6 in 1941 to Samuel and Anna Dailey; he attended Taft High School and
7 went on to serve his country in Vietnam as a member of the United
8 States Army; he later resumed his schooling, earning an LVN license
9 from St. Philip's College and a bachelor's degree in political
10 science and speech from St. Mary's University; and

11 WHEREAS, Pastor Dailey married the former Ruth Clay on August
12 18, 1962, and since that time, they have been blessed with three
13 sons, Carl, James Edward, and Darrel, and four grandchildren; the
14 couple have also been devoted foster parents for 14 years, and
15 Pastor Dailey has shared his expertise as president of the San
16 Antonio Foster Parent Association; and

17 WHEREAS, In 1978, this notable Texan began his church
18 leadership as pastor of Open Door Pentecostal; after two years, he
19 and Sister Dailey founded the United Apostolic Church, where their
20 moral and spiritual guidance has inspired congregants for nearly
21 three decades; and

22 WHEREAS, In addition to his work with United Apostolic,
23 Pastor Dailey has directed the youth at True Holiness and has served
24 as chair of Southern District Fellowship and as district elder for

1 the Texas State Council board; and

2 WHEREAS, His professional endeavors have included a
3 five-year tenure with Edgewood Independent School District as well
4 as the operation of his own business, A-1 Referral Service;
5 moreover, he has worked as an instructor at the language school at
6 Lackland Air Force Base, and his dedicated efforts in that role
7 earned him the title of Teacher of the Year; and

8 WHEREAS, This esteemed clergyman has further given back to
9 his fellow residents through his service as a director for the San
10 Antonio Neighborhood Association and as a board member for C.O.P.S.
11 and Metro Alliance; he has also led the Dellcrest Area Neighborhood
12 Association as president and served as a member of its board; and

13 WHEREAS, Carl and Ruth Dailey's ongoing efforts in behalf of
14 their congregation and the greater community have earned them the
15 lasting respect and admiration of countless individuals, and they
16 merit special recognition; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
18 Legislature hereby congratulate Carl Dailey on his 67th birthday
19 and honor Carl and Ruth Dailey for their 46th wedding anniversary;
