10 Boone; their family grew to include two sons, Jerry and Dan, as well
11 as four grandsons, five great-grandchildren, and two

13 WHEREAS, The Boones lived in Fort Worth until 1956, when Mr.
14 Boone's work with Conoco Oil took the family to Ponca City,
15 Oklahoma; following his retirement, they moved back to Fort Worth
16 and then settled in Burleson in 1978; and

17 WHEREAS, A lifelong Methodist, Mrs. Boone is a member of the
18 congregation at the First United Methodist Church of Burleson; and

19 WHEREAS, Mrs. Boone has remained devoted to her family and
20 her faith through the decades, and it is a pleasure to congratulate
21 her on a century of life well lived; now, therefore, be it

23 Legislature hereby honor Alice Louise Boone on the occasion of her
