- 7 Officers' Training Corps and received his commission as a second
- 8 lieutenant in the United States Army; he was waiting to report for
- 9 officer training when he was killed in the crash of a Black Hawk
- 10 helicopter during a field exercise at College Station; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Zac Cook was born in Lufkin to David and Becky Cook
- 12 on March 4, 1986; he was a 2004 graduate of Lufkin High School,
- 13 where he was an all-star catcher on the baseball team and was voted
- 14 "Best Personality" by his class; and
- WHEREAS, A proud Aggie, Lieutenant Cook was a member of the
- 16 Corps of Cadets, Company D-1, and the Brazos Union Masonic Lodge No.
- 17 129 in Bryan; he was also a member of Parson's Mounted Cavalry,
- 18 serving as the section chief responsible for firing the cannon
- 19 during Texas A&M football games and other events; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Cook was an enthusiastic and
- 21 knowledgeable outdoorsman who loved to hunt and fish with his
- 22 brother, David; he pursued his love of the natural world at Texas
- 23 A&M and earned his degree in wildlife and fisheries sciences; he
- 24 will also be remembered as a tough competitor and a loyal teammate

- 2 WHEREAS, A natural leader and a true patriot, Zac Cook
- 3 succeeded in achieving his dream of becoming an officer in the
- 4 service of his nation; although his life has ended far too soon, the
- 5 memory of his honesty, courage, determination, and compassion will
- 6 live forever in the hearts of all those who knew and loved him; now,
