- 7 Valley's bountiful winter harvest of grapefruit and oranges and
- 8 began the colorful tradition of crowning a King Citrus and Queen
- 9 Citrianna and their royal court; every city in the region further
- 10 appoints a duchess to represent its community at the coronation;

- 12 WHEREAS, Held annually since World War II, the fiesta is
- 13 enjoyed by thousands of attendees from the United States and
- 14 Mexico; they gather to participate in a range of special events,
- 15 including a fashion exhibition of costumes made from citrus
- 16 products and the spectacular Parade of Oranges showcasing floats
- 17 decorated with fruit and other agricultural products from the area;

- 19 WHEREAS, This year's Citrus Fiesta was presided over by King
- 20 Citrus Tom Aderhold, who throughout his life has been a leader in
- 21 the Valley's citrus industry; sharing the throne was Queen
- 22 Citrianna Lauren Yvanna Guerra, who was supported by the members of
- 23 the royal court: Maria Apolonia Calderon, the Princess of
- 24 Grapefruit Blossom, Katheryn Hinojosa, the Princess of Orange

- 1 Blossom, and Sophia Anyssa Flores, the Lady in Waiting; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Tangerine Court were Ryann Avery
- 3 Ramirez, the 59th Princess Anna, Madison Nicole Gerlach, the
- 4 Princess of Lemon Blossom, Kayla Nicole Cantu, the Princess of Lime
- 5 Blossom, Myrhissa Calen Ortega, the Princess of Tangerine Blossom,
- 6 and Jenna Renee Hard, the Princess of Grapefruit Blossom; also
- 7 presented at the court's coronation were 18 duchesses from the
- 8 region; and
- 9 WHEREAS, For more than 70 years, the combination of
- 10 agricultural abundance and the vibrant community spirit in the Rio
- 11 Grande Valley has helped make the Texas Citrus Fiesta one of the
- 12 landmark cultural events in the Lone Star State, and this
- 13 outstanding Texas tradition is truly deserving of special
- 14 recognition; now, therefore, be it
