RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, A group from Baylor University is visiting the State 2 Capitol on February 19, 2009, and this occasion provides a fitting opportunity to pay tribute to the rich history of this notable 3 institution; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Baylor University dates back to 1841, when delegates at the Union Baptist Association meeting accepted a 6 proposal by the Reverend William Milton Tryon and State District 7 Judge R. E. B. Baylor to create a Baptist university in Texas; the 8 Texas Baptist Education Society later petitioned the Congress of 9 the Republic of Texas, and, on February 1, 1845, an act was signed 10 11 into law that officially established Baylor University; Reverend 12 Tryon and Judge Baylor are regarded as the founders of the university, along with the Reverend James Huckins, who was the 13 14 first Baptist missionary to Texas and the university's first full-time fund-raiser; each year in February, the Baylor University 15 16 community hosts a Founders Day celebration to commemorate the anniversary of its charter; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Today, Baylor University is a nationally ranked liberal arts institution with a population of more than 14,000 19 20 students working toward degrees in 145 areas of study; this private 21 college is small enough to offer its students personal attention but large enough to feature Big 12 athletics programs and nearly 300 22

community service, and students, faculty, and staff volunteer
