3 Scout, and this accomplishment was duly recognized at a Court of
4 Honor on February 8, 2009; and

6 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
7 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
8 criteria, Ben Hughes earned 39 merit badges and, for his Eagle Scout

10 College of Agriculture and Life Sciences on the Texas A&M
11 University campus; and

19 Hughes has participated in varsity golf and the Young Life program;
20 he also serves the congregation of St. Thomas Episcopal Church as an
21 acolyte and has attended the Episcopal Youth Conference; and

22 WHEREAS, This fine young Texan's dedication and perseverance
23 in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy to stand among
24 scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with pride on a job well

1 done; now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
3 Legislature hereby congratulate Benjamin Nicholas Hughes on
4 achieving the rank of Eagle Scout and extend to him sincere best
5 wishes for continued success and happiness; and, be it further
