10 Scott, was born; and

11 WHEREAS, Judy McLeod has been active in parent-teacher
12 associations and numerous other organizations in Round Rock,
13 including Little League and Pony-Colt Baseball, the YMCA, and the
14 United Way, and she served as president of the school board from
15 1993 to 1995; currently, she is a member of the board at Seton
16 Medical Center Williamson and president of Seton Volunteers, and
17 she played an important role in the campaign to bring the Round Rock
18 Express minor-league baseball team to town in 2000; and

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Wade McLeod has operated McLeod Animal Clinic,
20 for 35 years, having founded it in the mid-1970s; countless area
21 residents have made use of his services through the decades, and his
22 hard work has built the clinic into a well-known business; and

23 WHEREAS, The dedicated efforts of Wade and Judy McLeod are
24 helping to make Round Rock an even better place to live and work,

1 and their actions are greatly appreciated by their fellow citizens;
