R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Members of the American Federation of State, County
2 and Municipal Employees Corrections Council 7 in Huntsville have
3 distinguished themselves through their generous assistance to
4 correctional officers affected by Hurricane Ike; and

5 WHEREAS, In the aftermath of the hurricane, union members
6 began coordinating efforts to help correctional officers located in
7 the devastated Gulf Coast region; they collected and prepared a
8 variety of essential goods, including food, ice, water, and hygiene
9 kits, and distributed them to officers in Beaumont, Dayton, Texas
10 City, and Angleton; and

11 WHEREAS, The contributions of these caring public servants
12 remind us that many individuals working together for a noble
13 purpose define the best sense of community and that the strength of
14 a society can be judged by its response to those in need; now,
15 therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
17 Legislature hereby commend the members of the American Federation
18 of State, County and Municipal Employees Corrections Council 7 for
19 their Hurricane Ike relief efforts and recognize them for their
