1 WHEREAS, Family and friends are mourning the sad loss of 2 realtor and community leader Joseph Alan Stivers of Huntsville, who 3 died on October 10, 2008, at the age of 60; and

WHEREAS, Joe Stivers was born on January 20, 1948, to Frank and Elizabeth Stivers; he grew up in Houston and spent his adolescence in Germany and Switzerland; he attended Wharton Junior College and graduated from Sam Houston State University with a degree in journalism; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Stivers began his professional career working 10 for Holiday Inn and highlighting local clubs and restaurants in 11 "Huntsville After Dark," his column for the *Huntsville Item*; he 12 then worked for Kansas City Life Insurance Company; and

13 WHEREAS, After working with several real estate brokers, he 14 started his own company, Joe Stivers and Associates, and later 15 purchased and served as principal broker of Elkins Lake Real 16 Estate; he also served on the Huntsville Board of Realtors; and

WHEREAS, An active and engaged member of his community, Mr. Stivers served on the Huntsville-Walker County Chamber of Commerce, where he was elected president in 1998; he was an esteemed 21-year member of the Rotary Club, which recognized him as a Paul Harris Fellow; he also served as chair of the annual Lobster Fiesta for a number of years; and

23 WHEREAS, This outstanding Texan loved politics and was the 24 Walker County chair of the Republican Party from 1980 until the

1 early 1990s, attending both state and national conventions; he was 2 appointed by Governor George W. Bush to the Texas Commission on Law 3 Enforcement Officer Standards and Education in 1997, was 4 reappointed by Governor Rick Perry, and served until 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, Joe Stivers was a keen student of genealogy and the 6 history of Texas; he treasured the time he spent with his family and 7 friends, and those he leaves behind will in turn cherish their 8 memories of the time they spent in his company; now, therefore, be 9 it
