3 21, 2008, at the age of 84; and

4 WHEREAS, Born to George Augustus Brown and Augusta Linn Brown
5 on March 10, 1924, in Alpine, Mary Linn Brown grew up on the
6 Haley-Brown Ranch at the foot of Cathedral Mountain, south of town;
7 affectionately known as "Mimze" to her family and friends, she
8 enjoyed the companionship of two brothers, John and George, and
9 three sisters, Margaret, Catherine, and Josephine; and

10 WHEREAS, A gifted dancer, she moved to New York City and
11 performed professionally with the New York City Ballet, working
12 with famed choreographer George Balanchine and the company's first
13 *prima ballerina*, Maria Tallchief; she also had the opportunity to
14 appear in several films; and

15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Reider and her husband, the actor Edward
16 "Eddie" Reider, were married in 1949; she lived in Los Angeles for a
17 number of years before returning to the family ranch in 1968; and

18 WHEREAS, Mary Linn Reider lived a rewarding life that was
19 rich in family, friends, and meaningful artistic accomplishments,
20 and she will forever hold a treasured place in the hearts of her
21 loved ones; now, therefore, be it
