1 WHEREAS, The Rites of Passage Program for Girls is hosting
2 its third biennial Women of Wisdom banquet on February 28, 2009, in
3 Dallas; and

4 WHEREAS, Established in 1998, Rites of Passage Program for
5 Girls is a nonprofit organization that offers a seven-year training
6 and development program for young women beginning in the sixth
7 grade; ROPP for Girls operates with a mission to affirm the positive
8 aspects of passing from childhood to adulthood and to instill in its
9 participants strong character traits and moral standards; the
10 program emphasizes community involvement, cultural appreciation,
11 healthy lifestyle choices, and the importance of self-esteem; and

12 WHEREAS, The Women of Wisdom banquet honors five women who
13 have made significant contributions to the Dallas community
14 throughout their lives; proceeds from the event will offset the
15 travel expenses of junior and senior level ROPP participants to
16 attend a two-week, educational and service-oriented trip to Ghana,

19 encourages good citizenship, compassion, and service, and its
