- 2 were commemorated with the dedication of Lucile McKee Hendricks

- 15 becoming the first female elected official in Hidalgo County; and

- 17 board and became its first female president in 1959; this dynamic
- 18 Texan also worked in the family construction business, which she
- 19 ran after the death of her husband, and through the years she served
- 20 on several civic commissions and gave generously of her time and
- 21 talents to numerous political, cultural, and philanthropic
- 22 organizations; her family members have donated books to the new
- 23 school's library; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Lucile Hendricks was an outstanding role model

- 1 throughout her long life, and she left an indelible imprint on the
- 2 city of McAllen; it is indeed fitting that an elementary school
- 3 should bear the name of this industrious and dedicated citizen;
