1 WHEREAS, Dr. William Doyle Farney of Georgetown retired as

2 the director of the University Interscholastic League on January

3 30, 2009, concluding a long and accomplished tenure in which he

4 skillfully supervised the academic, athletic, and music contests

5 that help enrich the education of the state's students; and

6 WHEREAS, An accomplished scholar and athlete during his own

7 high school years in Chilton, Bill Farney was valedictorian of his

8 graduating class and earned academic and football scholarships to

9 Paris Junior College and the University of Tulsa; after earning his

10 bachelor's degree at Tulsa in 1963, he completed graduate studies

11 in education at Baylor University, receiving a master's degree in

12 1968 and a doctorate in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Farney's extensive experience as an educator

14 began in 1962, when he became an English teacher in Tulsa; he went

15 on to work as a principal and superintendent with the Lorena,

16 Robinson, and Crawford school districts in Texas, and he also

17 coached athletic teams in numerous sports; and

18 WHEREAS, He joined the University Interscholastic League

19 staff in 1977 as assistant director and athletic director; his

20 exemplary work in those positions continued until 1995, when he

21 took the helm as director; through more than three decades of

22 service with UIL, Dr. Farney earned a reputation for calm

23 professionalism that allowed him to deal effectively with school

24 officials in order to achieve consensus on complex issues; and
