1           WHEREAS, Demonstrating great skill and dedication, the  
2 six-man football team from Greenville Christian School captured the  
3 2008 Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools Division 1  
4 state six-man football championship on December 6, 2008; and

5           WHEREAS, The Greenville Eagles took the title in a thrilling  
6 contest with the team from Heritage Christian Academy in Rockwall;  
7 the two teams stood even at 48-48 going into the fourth quarter at  
8 Moody ISD Stadium, but Greenville stayed tough on both sides of the  
9 ball to leave the field victorious by a 72-48 margin, clinching its  
10 second state title in as many years; and

11           WHEREAS, The championship triumph capped a spectacular year  
12 for Greenville, in which the Eagles completed the first undefeated  
13 season in school history, winning 12 games and dispatching several  
14 opponents by seven touchdowns or more; several Eagles players  
15 received all-state honors for their exceptional play, including  
16 Brandon Fauley, Josh Rook, Tanner Barnes, Blake Caspari, Jake  
17 Schumann, Jordan Henderson, and Andrew Wombaker; and

18           WHEREAS, Head coach Larry Uland and his assistants David  
19 Wombaker, Todd Barnes, Rene Aja, Kelly Garrett, Jim Johnson, and  
20 Dan Uland provided inspiration and guidance to the Greenville  
21 athletes throughout the season, encouraging them at every step to  
22 apply and improve their skills; moreover, Larry Uland's excellent  
23 record earned him the 2008 TAPPS Division 1 Coach of the Year honor;

1           WHEREAS, Winning a state championship represents the  
2 culmination of countless hours of hard work and an unwavering  
3 commitment to excellence, and the Greenville Eagles football team  
4 will treasure the memory of this accomplishment for many years to  
5 come; now, therefore, be it
