- News & World Report; the department's faculty includes many members 10
- 11 who hold leadership positions in rehabilitation organizations, as
- 12 well as recognized experts in such specializations as psychiatric
- disabilities, addictions, and assistive technology; and 13
- 14 WHEREAS, Undergraduate students gain valuable field
- experience and enjoy numerous opportunities for professional 15
- 16 development through community involvement; a 2007 report
- Hispanic Outlook in Higher Education recognized the department for 17
- graduating more Hispanics than any other rehabilitation program in 18
- the nation, and its bilingual graduates are in great demand in South 19
- 20 Texas and across the country; and
- 21 WHEREAS, In order to meet the growing need for rehabilitation
- educators, the department has plans to offer 22 a Ph.D. in
- 23 rehabilitation counseling beginning in fall 2009; only 26
- universities in the United States offer such a curriculum, and the 24

- 1 program will be the only one of its kind in Texas; and
