1 WHEREAS, David McKinnon White of Boy Scouts of America Crew
2 No. 670 in San Antonio has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and
3 this accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout insignia is a significant
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
7 criteria, Mr. White earned the requisite 21 merit badges, including

10 project of benefit to his community, which consisted in part of the

15 scouting career, winning the respect and admiration of his fellow
16 scouts as he worked toward the highest distinction that scouting
17 offers; he was venturing crew president, and, as a Cub Scout, he
18 earned the Arrow of Light Award; and

20 perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy to
21 stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with pride
22 on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
