1 WHEREAS, Senior Corporal Victor Antonio Lozada, Sr., of the
2 Dallas Police Department was killed in the line of duty on February
3 22, 2008, at the age of 49, and his untimely death was a tragic loss
4 to his family, to his fellow peace officers, and to the citizens of
5 Dallas; and

6 WHEREAS, Senior Corporal Lozada exemplified in his personal
7 and professional conduct the singular virtues of courage,
8 integrity, and unwavering dedication; and

9 WHEREAS, Throughout his 20-year tenure on the force, he
10 compiled a record of meritorious service, earning 138
11 commendations, a Life Saving Award, and a Certificate of Merit; he
12 also worked to keep young people out of harm's way by encouraging
13 them to stay off the streets and out of gangs; and

14 WHEREAS, Devotion to family and community formed the
15 foundation on which this highly respected public servant built his
16 life, and he will long be remembered for his commitment to helping
17 others; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 81st Texas
19 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Senior Corporal
20 Victor Lozada and extend deepest sympathy to the members of his
21 family: to his wife, Theresa Lozada; to his children, Victor
22 Antonio Lozada, Jr., Lisa Anne Lozada, Stephanie Andrea Lozada, and
23 David Alexander Lozada; to his mother, Josefina Lozada; to his
24 sisters and brother; and to his other relatives and many friends;
