1 WHEREAS, The T. Boone Pickens Mentoring Hall of Fame in
2 Irving is opening its doors in March 2009; and

3 WHEREAS, Highlighting the positive difference mentoring has
4 helped to make in many lives, the museum and resource center is a
5 project of Big Brothers Big Sisters of North Texas, which matches
6 young people with mentors in 25 area counties; in 2006 alone, this
7 record-setting chapter provided mentors to more than 6,000
8 children; and

9 WHEREAS, The generous support of the T. Boone Pickens
10 Foundation has contributed greatly to the work and success of the
11 chapter; in addition to a \$2 million grant that helped Big Brothers
12 Big Sisters of North Texas boost its mentorships, the foundation
13 also donated \$1.275 million that will be used to remodel existing
14 facilities and create the new Mentoring Hall of Fame and resource
15 center; and

17 set our youth on a path to a bright future, and the T. Boone Pickens
18 Mentoring Hall of Fame honors the outstanding Texans who have
