1           WHEREAS, Ridglea Hills Elementary School in Fort Worth was  
2 named a 2008 Just for the Kids--Higher Performing School by the  
3 National Center for Educational Achievement; and

4           WHEREAS, Established in 1995 by the NCEA, Just for the Kids is  
5 a program designed to find and fulfill every school's potential for  
6 reaching academic excellence and to ensure that all students are  
7 prepared for college and careers; JFTK identifies Higher Performing  
8 Schools that meet stringent criteria over multiple years and across  
9 all subjects; the best practices of these institutions are measured  
10 to determine a framework for improvement in other schools, and the  
11 Higher Performing Schools serve as models for raising scholastic  
12 standards nationwide; and
