6 Independent School District, where she chose to serve in low  
7 socioeconomic schools; and

9 served as a powerful example for them with her well-known zest for  
10 learning; one of her proudest accomplishments is sponsoring CCISD's  
11 first Odyssey of the Mind middle school team, which went on to reach  
12 the state competition; and

13           WHEREAS, In addition to her work in the classroom, Mrs. Oden  
14 distinguished herself as a member of state committees charged with  
15 reviewing textbooks and writing curriculum, and she gave several  
16 presentations at reading and writing workshops; she retired in  
17 1998, and she and her husband, John, moved to Rowlette to live near  
18 their daughter, Johnette, and her family; and
