6 Pastor Brent Boatwright, who currently provides caring guidance to

9 in 1990, the congregation of First Baptist replaced the structure
10 with a determination and optimism that touched others throughout
11 the community; a recently published book detailing the first
12 half-century of First Baptist includes photographs of the fire and

14 WHEREAS, Today, the church offers opportunities for
15 spiritual enrichment to the wider community through various
16 outreach programs; among its efforts, the church sponsors
17 ministries for children, singles, and seniors, as well as regular
18 mission trips; and

19 WHEREAS, For half a century, First Baptist Church has
20 remained a source of strength, comfort, and inspiration for Central
21 Texans, and it is fitting to recognize its congregants, past and
22 present, on the occasion of this notable milestone; now, therefore,
