## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, On March 11, 2009, many proud residents of the city
- 2 of Corsicana and Navarro County are gathering in Austin to
- 3 celebrate Corsicana/Navarro County Day at the State Capitol; and
- WHEREAS, Officially organized in 1846, the county is named
- 5 for Jose Antonio Navarro, a signer of the Texas Declaration of
- 6 Independence and a prominent leader during the days of the Texas
- 7 Republic and early statehood; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The arrival of the Houston and Texas Central
- 9 Railroad in the early 1870s helped to spur the development of this
- 10 region; the county's multifaceted economy now revolves around
- 11 agriculture, advanced manufacturing, information technology, and
- 12 the oil and gas industries; and
- WHEREAS, Corsicana was established in 1848 to serve as the
- 14 Navarro County seat and became a prosperous commercial center in
- 15 the late 1880s; in 1894, drillers seeking more water for the town's
- 16 growing population struck oil and gas instead and their find, the
- 17 earliest major oil discovery west of the Mississippi, led to the
- 18 state's first oil boom; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Over the years, this initial strike was followed by
- 20 the discovery of several additional oil fields; since 1895, Navarro
- 21 County has produced more than 200 million barrels and today has the
- 22 longest continual flow of oil in Texas; moreover, Corsicana holds
- 23 the distinction of being the first city in Texas to use gas for fuel
- 24 and lighting; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Corsicana is world-famous for its DeLuxe Fruitcake,
- 2 a creation of the 113-year-old Collin Street Bakery; shipped
- 3 throughout the United States and to more than 200 foreign countries
- 4 each year, this confection holds the prestigious Gourmet Society
- 5 Culinary Merit Award; and
- 6 WHEREAS, A charming community and the largest town in the
- 7 county, Corsicana features many attractions, including the Lefty
- 8 Frizzell Country Music Museum, the Warehouse Living Arts Center,
- 9 the award-winning restored Palace Theater, and Pioneer Village, a
- 10 historical recreation of a 19th century town; in addition, Navarro
- 11 College is home to one of the finest Native American art collections
- 12 in the Southwest at the Gaston C. Gooch Library, the Cook Center for
- 13 Arts, Science, and Technology, and the extensive Pearce Collection
- 14 Museum of Civil War and Western Art; and
- WHEREAS, Visitors and locals alike can keep up with news and
- 16 events in Corsicana and the region by reading the Corsicana Daily
- 17 Sun, whose presses have been rolling now for more than a century;

- 19 WHEREAS, This geographically diverse area is a haven for
- 20 outdoor and water enthusiasts, who find ample opportunity for
- 21 boating, fishing, skiing, and numerous other activities at
- 22 Richland-Chambers Reservoir, Navarro Mills Lake, and Lake Halbert;

- 24 WHEREAS, The citizens of Corsicana and Navarro County are
- 25 continuing to build on their colorful history and rich heritage,
- 26 and it is most appropriate to honor them as they embrace the myriad
- 27 challenges and opportunities of the future; now, therefore, be it
