Patterson, Sr., is an outstanding Texan who 2 long distinguished himself through his professional 3 achievements and his many years of community leadership; and WHEREAS, A native of Waxahachie, Mr. Patterson graduated in 4 5 1954 from Booker T. Washington High School in Wichita Falls and went on to earn a bachelor's degree from Bishop College, where he served 6 7 as editor of the newspaper; he began work as a private school teacher in 1959, but soon answered his country's call to arms during 8 9 the Vietnam War, serving as a member of the U.S. Army; his varied career also includes service as a commander in the Navy Reserve, as 10 11 executive director of the Community Action Board, and as assistant 12 to the dean of the College of Business Administration at Texas Tech University for more than a decade; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Patterson became co-publisher of the Southwest Digest, along with his friend Eddie P. Richardson, in 1984; in the 15 16 years since then, the two men have worked to keep Lubbock's African American community informed on a range of pertinent news; the 17
