16 Kilgore Crisis Center, the Texas Shakespeare Festival, Habitat for
17 Humanity, and the Boys and Girls Clubs; he has served on the East
18 Texas Regional Airport Economic Development Board and on the boards
19 of East Texas Baptist University, the Kilgore Independent School
20 District, the East Texas Treatment Center, and the Kilgore
21 Historical Preservation Foundation; and

23 on the active engagement of its citizens, and Lloyd Bolding stands
24 at the forefront of those individuals who are making a positive
